**Required Documents** (Note: Documents must be uploaded to application system!)

- a) Bachelor of Science / Master of Science diploma accepted as valid by Higher Education Council
- b) A copy of an approved transcript & a document including information about course content
- c) Resume or CV (including contact information)
- d) Result page of ALES, GRE or GMAT exams (*optional*)
- e) Certificate of International Language Proficiency (For PhD Programmes)
- f) A copy of Passport

*Candidate students who will apply for a PhD Program must have a grade above 55 taken from YDS or an equivalent exam approved by Interuniversity Board. Candidates who have none of these certificates must get a grade 60 out of 100 on the English Proficiency Exam presented by Aksaray University.*

It is not required to have a certificate of English proficiency for those who are graduated from a BS or MS program in English to apply a PhD program.

**Documents Required for Final Registration;**

- a) An original copy or a copy approved by Notary or by Consulship of BS or MS diploma,
- b) An original copy or a copy approved by Notary or by Consulship of BS or MS transcript,
- c) An original copy or a copy approved by Notary of result page of ALES, GRE or GMAT (*optional*),
- d) English proficiency certificate approved its equivalence by the Interuniversity Board or a result page of the English Proficiency Exam presented by Aksaray University(*optional*),
- e) For the programs which their education language is Turkish, an original copy or a copy approved by Notary of Turkish Proficiency Certificate given by ASÜTÖMER or YEE (*optional*),
- f) A copy of Passport (If it is not in English, its approved translation in Turkish),
- g) 3 Photos (taken in the last six months),
- h) Receipt of Tuition Fee.
- i) Approved Translation Copies of Documents in Turkish & English



### **EVALUATION OF APPLICATIONS**

- (a) Evaluation of candidates applying to graduate programs is made by taking 20% of ALES (if any), 70% of undergraduate graduation grade and 10% of scientific work for master's programs with and without thesis. Reserve candidates are determined as much as the number of quotas.
- (b) For those who will apply to doctoral programs with a master's degree, 20% of the ALES (if any), 50% of the master's graduation grade, 20% of the foreign language score, and 10% of the scientific studies are evaluated. Reserve candidates are determined as much as the number of quotas.
- (c) ALES (or equivalent) condition is not required for postgraduate or postgraduate doctorate applications. Candidates who will apply for a doctorate with a bachelor's degree must obtain at least 80 points from ALES or GRE, GMAT exams, and meet the requirement of at least 3 out of 4 or equivalent in terms of undergraduate graduation grade point average.

Candidates who want to study postgraduate education by certifying that they have a scholarship from the State of the Republic of Turkey or their own state can be admitted to graduate programs out of the quota, with the opinion of the EABD/EASD Board and the decision of the EYK.

Application results are announced on the related institute website. Candidates who have the right to register will obtain their acceptance letters from the online application system. With this letter, the candidates will be sent to their country or the nearest T.C. Embassy or Consulate. They must obtain a student visa from the Embassy or Consulate.
